After his retained counsel withdrew, Oliver Hooper filed a motion to have counsel appointed to represent him in his habeas corpus proceeding. To avoid a prolonged delay, Hooper shall file the completed forms, a motion for an extension of time, or a notice that he intends to proceed pro se **on or before November 16, 2009**. If Hooper fails to do so, the case may be dismissed.
