Dear Judge Schneider:

This letter responds to Your Honor's June 14, 2007 Letter Order asking the parties to address whether the above-referenced actions should be consolidated for discovery and case management purposes.

Plaintiffs in the *CSPI* action are in agreement with counsel for defendants and counsel for Melfi that both of these pending cases, as well as the case of *Simmens v. Coca-Cola Company* (E.D. Pa. No. 07-668), in which a motion for transfer to this Court has been granted, should be consolidated for case management and discovery. Plaintiffs further suggest that the Court consolidate these three cases for all purposes, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 42(a), because all three cases now seek class certification and the questions of law and fact are nearly identical in all three complaints.
