Dear Clerk of Court,


Please accept this letter as a formal objection to the proposed settlement offered in the mediation with the pet food companies in the court case above. My objection is that this proposed settlement has no provisions for the ongoing vet expenses directly associated with my cat eating the contaminated cat food.

My cat, Moika, was one and a half years old when she ate the contaminated Iams Salmon in Sauce in January 2007. After a week of vet visits and two and a half days in intensive care, Moika survived. Over the past year, I have incurred additional expenses in follow up vet visits that include ultrasounds, blood work and further treatments for crystals found in Moika's urine that the vets believe are a direct result of the contaminated cat food.

Moika is now three years old and is still on a special renal prescription diet as a result of the poisoned cat food. This prescription diet is much more expensive than regular cat food. My vet recommends, at minimum, yearly blood work and possibly more tests to monitor her damaged kidneys. There is nothing in this settlement to cover these continuing expenses.

A fair and reasonable settlement would have provisions to cover care for animals still under treatment. Please reject this proposed settlement as insufficient and inadequate to cover the basic ongoing costs directly associated with the pet food poisoning of my cat, Moika, and other pets still undergoing treatment. Thank you for your time and consideration.
