13	STATEMENT OF THE ISSUES
14	The Appellant, Donald R. Earl, filed a product
15	liability action in Washington State Superior Court against
16	Menu Foods Income Fund and The Kroger Company for damages
17	related to unrecalled pet food. Menu Foods Income Fund held
18	two bodies of evidence which it designated `unorganized
19	inventory' and 'organized inventory'. The 'organized
20	inventory' was made up of recalled pet food relevant to the
21	instant case. The `unorganized inventory' contained
22	unrecalled pet food evidence material to the action pending
23 24	in Washington State. Defendant manufacturers in the instant
24	case filed a motion, which in part asked the court for
25	permission to destroy all evidence material to Earl's
27	Washington State action (unorganized inventory), which the
28	court granted. Washington courts subsequently denied Earl's
	right to conduct discovery of the `unorganized inventory'

1 based on the principal of comity. Earl moved the court to 2 intervene and vacate the order permitting destruction of 3 evidence, which the trial court denied. 4 **ISSUE 1**: Does an attorney, in filing a motion to 5 destroy evidence, violate 3.4(a) of the Rules of 6 Professional Conduct? 7 ISSUE 2: Did the trial court have subject matter 8 jurisdiction to consider a motion to destroy evidence? 9 10 ISSUE 3: Did the trial court, contrary to criminal 11 statutes designed to preserve evidence, have legal authority 12 to grant defendant manufacturers permission to destroy 13 evidence? 14 ISSUE 4: Did the trial court err in denying the motions 15 to intervene and to vacate the order permitting destruction 16 of evidence, which was material to cases over which the 17 court does not have jurisdiction? 18 19 Dated: March 4, 2009 Respectfully submitted by: 20 21 22 23 Donald R.
