Plaintiff brings this suit against Defendant to reduce to judgement the alleged delinquent contributions. Presently before the Court is Plaintiff's motion for entry of default judgment against Defendant (Doc. No. 8). For the reasons set forth in the accompanying opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's motion is GRANTED, and Defendant shall pay Plaintiff \$46,794.85 in damages.
