- 1. Facilitating Computer Fraud and Abuse by allowing users of their web sites and/or Internet Relay Chat (IRC) and/or public message forums available through their sites (hereafter referred to as "Internet Services"), to conspire, organize, incite or teach how to perpetrate electronic Denial of Service attacks which flood Plaintiff's web sites with data, for the purpose of making the data and communications in interstate commerce on HalTurnerShow.com, TurnerRadioNetwork.com and PrivateWebHosting.org unavailable, in violation of 18 United States Code §1030, the "Computer Fraud and Abuse Act."
- 2. Facilitating Common Law Fraud by allowing users of their Internet Services, to conspire, organize, or incite Common Law Fraud with automated "bandwidth leeching" attacks designed to mimic legitimate users but in reality deliberately and maliciously increase data flow into or out of Plaintiff's web sites

  HalTurnerShow.com, TurnerRadioNetwork.com and

  PrivateWebHosting.org for the purpose of inflicting financial damage to plaintiff in an effort to force him out of business through financial ruin.
- 3. Facilitating Extortion by allowing users of their Internet Services to conspire organize or incite

- 4. Facilitating Copyright Infringement by allowing users of their Internet Services to conspire, organize, incite, make copies or publish the location of unlawful electronic copies of Plaintiff's radio show which infringe upon Plaintiff's Copyright in violation of 17 United States Code § 106
- 5. Facilitating telephone harassment by allowing users of their internet services to conspire organize or incite unlawful telephone harassment against The Hal Turner Radio Show.
- 6. Facilitating telephone harassment by allowing users of their internet services to conspire, organize or incite unlawful telephone harassment and threats of violence to the private home telephone of Harold Turner;
- 7. Facilitating telephone harassment by allowing users of their internet services to conspire, organize or incite unlawful telephone harassment and threats of violence to

- 8. Facilitating Mail Fraud and Wire Fraud by allowing users of their internet services to conspire, organize or incite fraudulent requests for goods and services to be delivered to and billed to Hal Turner, in violation of 18 United States Code § 1341 and / or Wire Fraud in violation of 18 United States Code § 1343
- 9. Aiding and Abetting the acts referenced herein by allowing users of their Internet Services to post or publish messages to others anonymously, without means of tracking the actual identities of such users.

ORDERED that, sufficient reason having been shown therefore, pending the hearing of Plaintiff's application for a preliminary injunction, pursuant to Rule 65 of the Fed. R. Civ. P., the defendants are temporarily restrained and enjoined from engaging in all of the above referenced activity, and it is further
