ORDERED that Respondent appear on November 6, 2012 at 1:00 pm¹ at the IRS Office, 1719 C Route 10 East, Parsippany, New Jersey and bring with him the documents identified in the summons served upon him on February 1, 2012; and it is further

ORDERED that this case is **CLOSED**; and it is further

ORDERED that an IRS official shall personally serve Respondent with a copy of this Order and the United States shall file a Certificate of Service.
