IT IS, on this 16th day of January, 2014,

**ORDERED** that the motion to dismiss/for summary judgment [D.E. 8] is **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**:

- Counts five, six, and eight are dismissed;
- The claims against the State, the Department of Corrections, and Lagana in his
  official capacity are dismissed in their entirety;
- The claims against Lagana in his individual capacity are dismissed and **as to those claims only,** plaintiff is permitted to file an amended complaint on or

  before January 27, 2014.
- Defendants' motion is denied in all other respects;
