On November 14, 2014, the Clerk received Plaintiff's Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2241. (Doc No. 1.) Petitioner failed to pay the filing fee or submit an application to proceed without payment of fees, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. If Plaintiff cannot afford to pay \$5.00, he may submit a properly completed "Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis Non-Prisoner," which will be supplied to him by the Clerk of Court.

ORDERED that the Clerk shall administratively terminate this matter by making a new and separate entry reading, "CIVIL CASE TERMINATED"; and it is further

ORDERED that Petitioner may reopen this matter by submitting, within thirty days from the date of entry of this Opinion and Order, the \$5.00 filling fee or a properly executed form "Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis Non-Prisoner," accompanied by his 2241 petition; and no statement in this Opinion and Order shall be construed as withdrawal of this Court's jurisdiction; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk shall serve this Opinion and Order upon Plaintiff by regular U.S. Mail, together with the following blank form: "Application to Proceed In Forma Pauperis Non-Prisoner."
