OPINION

CHESLER, District Judge

This matter comes before the Court on the application filed by Plaintiff Desmond Witherspoon to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> without fees under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. The Court finds that Plaintiff qualifies for <u>in forma pauperis</u> status, yet his Complaint will be dismissed. The Court must examine Plaintiff's claim and dismiss it if frivolous or legally insufficient. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2). The Complaint states as its cause of action "Reorganization Act unde[r] 1939." The Court cannot discern what legal claim Plaintiff is even trying to assert, and the Complaint alleges no facts at all. As such, Plaintiff has failed to state a basis for federal subject matter jurisdiction, and he has failed to state a facially plausible claim for relief. For the reasons provided in the Opinion for Civil Action No. 14-6296, Plaintiff is on notice that he may be sanctioned if he continues to file unsubstantiated and repetitive lawsuits. An appropriate Order will be filed.
