

OPINION & ORDER

THE PLAINTIFF sought review of a determination by the Social Security Administration. (See *dk.* 1.) In an order entered April 18, 2017, the Court set forth a schedule pursuant to Local Civil Rule 9.1 for the prosecution of this appeal, and directed that the failure to timely file documents would result in the appeal being dismissed. (See *dk.* 11.) The plaintiff has failed to serve and file the required statement of the primary contentions or arguments for relief, even though the time to do so has elapsed. Therefore, for good cause appearing;

THE COURT hereby dismisses the complaint for lack of prosecution pursuant to Local Civil Rule 9.1 and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b); and it is further
