See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) (providing 14 days to object); Fed.R.Civ.P. 72(b)(2) (same); L.Civ.R. 72.1(c)(2) (same); see also Fed.R.Civ.P. 6(d) (providing additional three days to respond in certain instances); L.Civ.R. 5.2(5) (reiterating Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 6(d)); Fed.R.Civ.P. 6(a) (directing, inter alia, that if clerk’s office is inaccessible, then response period is extended to first accessible day that is not Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday).
