The Court previously screened Plaintiff's Complaint for dismissal pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) and dismissed the Complaint in its entirety pursuant to the Court's screening authority and provided Plaintiff with leave to amend as to those claims the Court dismissed without prejudice.
