

ORDER

The Stipulation of Award of Attorney Fees Under the Equal Access to Justice Act, filed August 23, 2017 (Doc. 27), is **GRANTED**. In consideration thereof, it is **ORDERED** that Defendant pay to Plaintiff reasonable attorney fees in the amount of \$6,500.00. Payment shall be to the Plaintiff, but mailed to Plaintiff's counsel. In addition, if Plaintiff's counsel ultimately receives an award of attorney fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b), he must refund the smaller award to Plaintiff pursuant to *Weakley v. Bowen*, 803 F.2d 575, 580 (10th Cir. 1986).
