

**ORDER FOR EXPEDITED BRIEFING**

Defendants Eduardo Lopez, Carol Hilton, and Deinna Dures filed a motion to stay discovery (Doc. 30) pending resolution of the motion to dismiss (Doc. 29), which includes a defense of qualified immunity.
