ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S PROPOSED FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDED DISPOSITION

THIS MATTER is before the Court on Magistrate Judge Steven C. Yarbrough's September 14, 2018 Proposed Findings and Recommended Disposition ("PFRD"). Doc. 29.
