ORDER QUASHING SHOW CAUSE ORDER

THIS MATTER is before the Court on its *Order to Show Cause* (the “Order”), (Doc. 12), filed July 15, 2022. The Court ordered Plaintiff to file a notice with the Court stating why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute or file the appropriate motion in accordance with the Federal Rules, by July 28, 2022.
