**ORDER ADOPTING MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S
PROPOSED FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDED DISPOSITION**

The Magistrate Judge filed her Proposed Findings and Recommended Disposition on April 15, 2016 (*Doc. 13*). The proposed findings notify Smith of his ability to file objections and that failure to do so waives appellate review. Smith's objections were originally due on May 2, 2016; however, he was granted an extension until June 1, 2016, to file his objections.
