## ORDER OF REFERENCE

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §§ 636(b)(1)(B), (b)(3), and *Va. Beach Fed. Sav. & Loan Ass'n v. Wood*, 901 F.2d 849 (10<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1990), this matter is referred to Magistrate Judge Gregory J. Objections must be filed within fourteen (14) days after being served with a cop of the proposed disposition.
