**BLOOM, United States Magistrate Judge:**

Defendant moves for reconsideration of the Court's Order dated March 15, 2012 on the ground that the Court "misapprehended Rule 50(b) in ordering defendant[] to serve post-trial motions by April 12, 2012." (Docket entry 136.) The Court did not "misapprehend" the Rules. Post-trial motions under Rule 50(b) or Rule 59 must be filed no later than twenty-eight days after the entry of judgment. Fed. R. Civ. P. 50(b), 59(b), 59(e). Before I entered the Order on March 15, 2012, a judgment was issued in accordance with the jury verdict. (Docket entry 138.) The judgment was entered on the docket today, March 16, 2012. (*Id.*) As judgment has been entered in this case, defendant's motion for reconsideration is denied. Defendant shall move for judgment as a matter of law or for a new trial within twenty-eight days of the entry of judgment.
