Dear Judge Reyes:

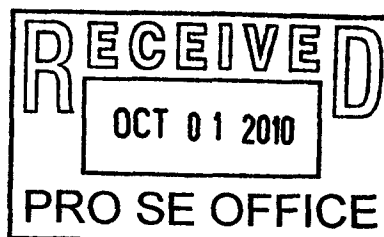

Moreover, we're sure that we've fully responded to Plaintiffs' Rule




