The Court, having considered Defendant's letter requesting an Order to Deposit the premiums in an Interest-Bearing Account, hereby:

ORDER

ORDERED that by April 11, 2016 John Hancock deposit with the Clerk of this Court \$635,794.44, representing the premiums paid for the policies that it seeks to rescind (the "Premiums"), which funds shall be wired by John Hancock to the attention of:

and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court deduct from the income on the investment a fee equal to ten per cent (10%) of the income earned, but not exceeding the fee authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States and set by the Director of the Administrative Office;

and it is further

ORDERED that the tendering of the Premium is without prejudice to Plaintiff seeking interest on the Premiums or the Defendant's claim for damages including, but not limited to, the amount of the Premiums.
