JURISDICTION

1. This is a civil action, seeking compensatory damages, punitive damages and attorney's fees.

2. This action is brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §§1983 and 1988 and the fourth and fourteenth amendments to the Constitution of the United States.

3. Jurisdiction is founded upon 28 U.S.C. §§1331,1343 and 1367.
