ANN DONNELLY, District Judge.

On March 22, 2017, the plaintiff, Steven Nabatov, sent the Court several pieces of paper, which appear to list dates, times, locations, as well as random names and phrases, none of which are connected in any way to any matter before the Court. The plaintiff is reminded that his case is closed and that no further action is appropriate in front of this Court.

Previously, on December 1, 2015, the plaintiff brought a pro se civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1989 against a judge, attorney, fire marshal, and private individuals. (ECF No. 1.) The Court dismissed the Complaint for failure to state a claim upon which relief can be granted on January 7, 2016. (ECF No. 12.) On January 21, 2016, the plaintiff filed a letter challenging the Court's decision. (ECF No. 13.) On January 26, 2016, the Court denied the plaintiff's challenge. The Clerk of the Court subsequently dismissed the action. (ECF No. 14.) There is no further relief that the plaintiff can obtain from this Court. If the plaintiff continues to submit letters to the Court in connection with this case, he may be barred from filing in the future.
