*Pro se* petitioner Rashaan Ingram, currently incarcerated at Five Points Correctional Facility in Romulus New York, brings the instant petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, challenging his May 18, 2013 Dutchess County Criminal Court conviction. Because petitioner is challenging a Dutchess County, New York conviction, the Clerk of Court is directed to transfer this case to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.<sup>1</sup> That provision of Rule 83.1 of the Local Rules of the Eastern District of New York which requires a seven day delay is waived. The Clerk of the Court is directed to mail a copy of this Order to the Petitioner and to close this case.
