Dear Judge Seybert:

Our law firm, located in Indianapolis, Indiana, is legal counsel to Australian Gold, Inc. Frances J. Earley with the law firm of Mintz, Levin, Cohn, Ferris, Glovsky and Popeo in New York is our co-counsel in this matter.

This Court previously set a summary judgment briefing schedule with each party's initial brief due on December 4, 2006 and the response briefs due on December 18, 2006.
