On April 28, 2014, incarcerated *pro se* plaintiff Jorge R. Perez Soto, Jr. ("plaintiff") commenced this action against the Assigned Counsel Defenders' Plan of Nassau County, Joseph A. Lopiccolo, Esq., Hession, Beckoff and Lopiccolo, LLP, and Nassau County District Attorney Kathleen M. Rice (collectively, the "defendants"), pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Accompanying the complaint is an application to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

Upon review of plaintiff's declaration in support of his application to proceed *in forma* pauperis, plaintiff's financial status qualifies him to commence this action without prepayment of the filing fees. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1). Accordingly, plaintiff's application to proceed *in forma pauperis* is GRANTED.
