By Memorandum and Order dated June 6, 2017 (the "June 6th M&O"), the Court denied the applications of then-incarcerated <u>proson</u> se plaintiff Keysean L. Keyes ("Plaintiff") to proceed <u>in formator pauperis</u> and directed Plaintiff to remit the Court's \$350 filing fee for each of the Complaints filed in the cases set forth above within fourteen (14) days of the date of the "June 6th M&O", and cautioned that her failure to do so will lead to the dismissal of her claims and judgment shall enter in each case.

To date, Plaintiff has not paid the fees, nor has she otherwise communicated with the Court about these cases.

Accordingly, the Complaints are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) for failure to prosecute.
