DECISION & ORDER

I. INTRODUCTION

The Amended Complaint in this *pro se* action was reviewed by the Hon. David R. Homer, United States Magistrate Judge. In a Report-Recommendation and Order dated August 20, 2011, Magistrate Judge Homer recommended that Plaintiff's complaint be dismissed as to all claims and all defendants pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b)(1) for failure to state a claim. 
II. CONCLUSION
