DECISION and ORDER

Plaintiff Tonie Ceballos filed this action on behalf of her minor dependant seeking judicial review of a final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying her application for Supplemental Security Income benefits for her child A.R.C. under the Social Security Act.
