DECISION and ORDER

Plaintiff filed this action in May 2006, seeking judicial review of the denial of Social Security benefits. By Report-Recommendation dated April 10, 2009, the Honorable Victor E. Bianchini, United States Magistrate Judge, recommended that defendant's motion for judgment on the pleadings be denied; plaintiff's cross-motion for judgment on the pleadings be denied in part and granted in part; and that this matter be remanded for reconsideration.
