## **DECISION and ORDER**

The above-captioned action comes to this Court following a Report-Recommendation by United States Magistrate Judge Victor E. Bianchini, filed on June 8, 2010, recommending that the Commissioner's decision denying disability benefits be remanded back to the Commissioner for further proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g).
