## **DECISION and ORDER**

Currently before the Court, in this action filed by James J. Doughty ("Plaintiff") against the Commissioner of Social Security ("Defendant") pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) seeking review of a decision by Defendant denying Plaintiff's application for Social Security benefits, is the Report-Recommendation of United States Magistrate Judge Christian F. Hummel, issued pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(A) and (B) and Local Rule 72.3(c) of the Local Rules of Practice for this Court, recommending that this action be dismissed in its entirety for Plaintiff's failure to timely file his complaint within the proscribed sixty (60) day filing period. the reasons stated therein.

**ACCORDINGLY**, it is

**ORDERED** that Magistrate Judge Hummel's Report-Recommendation (Dkt. No. 10) is

**ACCEPTED** and **ADOPTED** in its entirety; and it is further

**ORDERED** that Defendant's motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 8) is **GRANTED**; and it is

further

**ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Complaint (Dkt. No. 1) is **DISMISSED** in its entirety.
