This matter was referred to the Hon. Andrew T. 
**CONCLUSION**

After examining the record, this Court has determined that the Report and Recommendation is not subject to attack for plain error or manifest injustice. Therefore, the Court **ADOPTS** the Report and Recommendation [dkt. # 23] for the reasons stated therein. The decision of the Commissioner is **REVERSED**, and this case is **REMANDED**,

pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), for a proper evaluation of the medical opinion and other evidence, an appropriate determination of plaintiff's residual functional capacity, and other further proceedings, consistent with Magistrate Judge Baxter's Report and Recommendation.
