DECISION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Court following a Report-Recommendation filed on May 27, 2009, by the Honorable David E. Peebles, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and L.R. 72.3(c) of the Northern District of New York. Report-Rec. (Dkt. No. 15).

Furthermore, after examining the record, the Court has determined that the Report-Recommendation is not subject to attack for plain error or manifest injustice.

ORDERED, that the Report-Recommendation (Dkt. No. 15) is **APPROVED** and **ADOPTED** in its **ENTIRETY**; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Defendant's Motion for judgment on the pleadings is **GRANTED**, the

Commissioner's determination that Plaintiff was not disabled at the relevant times is **AFFIRMED**, and that Plaintiff's Complaint (Dkt. No. 1) is **DISMISSED** in all respects; and it is further **ORDERED**, that the Clerk serve a copy of this Order on all parties.
