HURD United States District Judge ORDER Plaintiff filed a second amended civil rights complaint on June 4, 2009 (Docket No. 9). It sets forth events which allegedly occurred in 1999-2000. Defendants filed a motion to dismiss pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(6) on August 17, 2009 (Docket No. 19). Plaintiff answered on August 24, 2009, in opposition, but does not challenge the dates of alleged events. (Docket No. 21).

The plaintiff's claims are barred pursuant to the three year statute of limitations under 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED, that

1. The defendants' motion is GRANTED; and

2. The complaint is DISMISSED.

The clerk is directed to file judgment accordingly and close the file.
