DECISION AND ORDER

This matter comes before the Court following a Report-Recommendation filed on May 17, 2010, by the Honorable David R. Homer, United States Magistrate Judge, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and L.R. 72.3(c) of the Northern District of New York. Report-Rec. (Dkt. No. 15).

Within fourteen days after a party has been served with a copy of a Magistrate Judge's Report-Recommendation, the party "may serve and file specific, written objections to the proposed findings and recommendations." FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b), in compliance with L.R. 72.1 of the Northern District of New York. No objections have been raised in the allotted time with respect to Magistrate Judge Homer's Report-Recommendation. Furthermore, after examining the record, the Court has determined that the Report-Recommendation is not subject to attack for plain error or manifest injustice.

ORDERED, that the Report-Recommendation (Dkt. No. 15) is **APPROVED** and **ADOPTED** in its **ENTIRETY**; and it is further


ORDERED, that the decision of the Commissioner is **REMANDED** for further
