Pro se plaintiff Raymond L. Jackson brought this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On November 7, 2017, the Honorable Christian F. Hummel, United States Magistrate Judge, advised by Report-Recommendation that plaintiff's amended complaint be dismissed without prejudice and with opportunity to amend. Therefore, it is


ORDERED that
