## **DECISION AND ORDER**

ORDERED, that Defendants' Motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim (Dkt. No. 15) is

GRANTED with prejudice with respect to Defendant Goord and Defendant Lemons in their official capacities, but with leave to amend with respect to Defendant Goord and Defendant Lemons in their

individual capacities; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Clerk serve a copy of this Order on all parties.
