Currently before the Court, in this *pro se* prisoner civil rights action filed by Mashama Hill (“Plaintiff”) against the above-captioned New York State correctional officer (“Defendant”), are (1) Plaintiff’s motion for summary judgment, (2) United States Magistrate Judge Baxter’s Report-Recommendation recommending that Plaintiff’s motion for summary judgment be denied, and (3) Plaintiff’s Objection to the Report-Recommendation. 
