DECISION and ORDER

I. INTRODUCTION

This *pro se* action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 was referred to the Hon. Thérèse Wiley Dancks, United States Magistrate Judge, for a Report and Recommendation pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b) and Local Rule N.D.N.Y. 72.3(c). In her May 29, 2013 Report-Recommendation (Dkt. No. 25), Magistrate Judge Dancks recommends that Defendant Johnson's motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 18) be denied. II. DISCUSSION


After examining the record, this Court has determined that the Report-Recommendation and Order is not subject to attack for plain error or manifest injustice.
