**DECISION and ORDER**

Pro se plaintiff Craig L. Johnson brought this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On July 13, 2020, the Honorable Miroslav Lovric, United States Magistrate Judge, advised by Report-Recommendation that defendants' motion for summary judgment

be granted and the Second Amended Complaint be dismissed in its entirety. After requesting an extension of time, plaintiff filed objections to the Report-Recommendation. Defendants responded to plaintiff's objections, and plaintiff replied to defendants' response.

Based upon a de novo review of the portions of the Report-Recommendation to which plaintiff objected, the Report-Recommendation is accepted and adopted in all respects. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1).


Therefore, it is
