STIPULATION AND REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2005, the Court entered a Stipulation and Revised Scheduling Order setting forth a schedule for discovery; and

WHEREAS the parties, notwithstanding their best efforts, are unable to complete fact discovery by the date set forth in that Stipulation and Order;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned attorneys for the respective parties, that the following revised discovery plan shall be in effect:

1. Discovery in the form of requests for production of documents, interrogatories and/or notices of deposition shall commence on October 22, 2004.
2. All fact discovery shall be completed by October 28, 2005.
3. Initial expert reports pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(a)(2) shall be served no later than November 16, 2005, and rebuttal expert reports shall be served no later than December 9, 2005.

- 4. All expert discovery, including deposition, shall be completed by January 6, 2006.
- 5. Discovery motions should be filed on or before the date designated for the close of each respective discovery period, if possible.
- 6. All potentially dispositive motions shall be filed by February 3, 2006.


