Attached with this letter are documents numbered 00385 - 01243. These documents are responsive to request numbers 1, 2, 3, and 4 of plaintiff's January 18, 2005 FOIA request (the "January 2005 Request"), and request number 4 of plaintiff's November 16, 2004 FOIA request (the "November 2004 Request"), as these requests have subsequently been interpreted and limited in the parties' proposed stipulation and order submitted to the Court on June 29, 2005. Identifying information pertaining to detainees and military personnel has been redacted from the documents responsive to request numbers 1, 2, and 3 of the January 2005 Request, and request number 4 of the November 2004 Request, pursuant to FOIA Exemption 6. Medical information concerning detainees has been redacted from pages 970, 987, and 1228, also pursuant to Exemption 6. The documents responsive to request number 4 of the November 2004 Request have also been redacted, in a single instance, pursuant to FOIA Exemption 1, which exemption is noted next to the corresponding redaction. No responsive documents have been withheld in full.

The enclosed documents constitute the entire universe of documents responsive to the foregoing requests, as subsequently interpreted and limited in the parties' stipulation, that DOD located as of the date of its search, June 8, 2005.


