My name is Vincent Montagne, Chairman of Media Participations Paris, a publishing group operating in France, Belgium and Switzerland through different subsidiaries namely Dargaud, Dupuis, Le Lombard, Fleurus, Magnificat, Mame, Mango, Kana, Rustica, etc. All those publishing houses are part of the settlement class embraced by the proposed settlement agreement that is before this Court in this action (the "Settlement Agreement"), because they own rights on books that are protected by U.S. copyright law. I write to object to the Settlement Agreement. My group does not have the resources to provide this Court with legal briefing regarding our objections nor do we wish to burden this Court with duplicative filings.
