With the agreement of counsel for plaintiff Jill Giles, Defendant Random House, Inc. moves the Court to stay all proceedings in this action pending a decision by the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation ("JPML") on Random House's motion to transfer and consolidate this and eleven other pending federal class actions for coordinated pretrial proceedings.¹ This case is one of twelve actions pending in federal courts across the country that arises out of the publishing and marketing of the book "A Million Little Pieces," written by defendant James Frey. A supporting memorandum is attached, and an agreed order will be submitted to the Court for its review.
