


This letter is to inform the Court that on June 20, 2007 plaintiffs filed a motion for leave to file an amended complaint. Although defendants initially stated that they intended to oppose plaintiffs' motion, defendants subsequently withdrew their opposition to plaintiffs' motion on July 5, 2007. Consequently, plaintiffs' motion is now unopposed.

In their notice of withdrawal, defendants made certain characterizations of plaintiffs' motion. Plaintiffs' motion, however, is anything but "groundless and defective". To the contrary, the facts set forth in plaintiffs' memorandum in support of their motion for leave to file an amended complaint establish facts sufficient to support the claims in plaintiffs' amended complaint.

an order be entered granting plaintiffs leave to file its amended complaint, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit A to the Forrest Declaration.


