
WHEREAS, in support of the Motion, on January 27, 2011, Plaintiffs filed via ECF a Declaration Of Kelly M. Klaus (the "Declaration"); and

WHEREAS, Exhibit 1 to the Declaration is comprised of certain downloads of sound recordings and data files verifying the act of the download and the content of each file, these downloads and data files being stored on a Seagate Free Agent GoFlex 320 GB hard drive with USB 2.0 Plug-and-play technology (the "Hard Drive");

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiffs shall be permitted to present the Hard Drive to the offices of the clerk of the Southern District of New York in the Pearl Street Courthouse and those offices shall accept the Hard Drive for filing in this matter.
