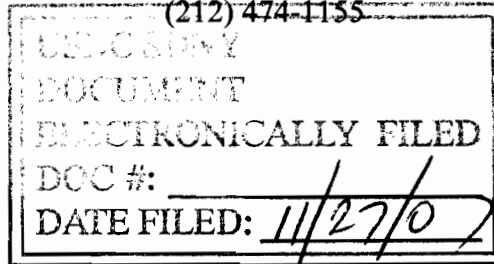

The parties jointly write this letter to the Court for approval to revise the Scheduling Order dated June 19, 2007, with respect to submission of expert reports.

The parties propose an immediate but limited modification of the Scheduling Order that would allow the parties to exchange affirmative expert reports on January 22, 2008, and rebuttal reports on February 22, 2008.

This scheduling change would provide interim relief pending resolution of the various scheduling issues set forth in the parties' letter to the Court dated October 19, 2007. While this proposal corresponds to the schedule proposed by the record company plaintiffs in their portion of the letter to this Court dated October 19, 2007, defendants' agreement is without prejudice to their position on scheduling set forth in that letter.

If the Court approves of this interim modification, we have provided a “so ordered” line below.


