Dear Jeff:

I am writing concerning the subpoenas that defendants in the above-captioned matter served on your clients, iMesh, Inc. ("iMesh") and MusicLab, LLC ("MusicLab").

I attach an order recently issued in the case by Magistrate Judge Freeman, which ordered VEVO LLC – another non-party subpoena recipient in this action – to produce the same three categories of documents that I informed you defendants were most interested in receiving from your clients: (1) agreements with the plaintiff record companies, (2) periodic reports submitted to the record companies showing amounts paid pursuant to such agreements, and (3) communications concerning the agreements, subject to search parameters set out in the order.

I am writing to inquire if your clients will produce the categories of documents described in the attached order (with emails, of course, from the files of your clients' appropriate custodians), or if they will stand on the objections set forth in your written objections and responses and your letter dated October 20, 2010. You previously told me that, were your clients to produce documents, they would do so only upon the entry of a stipulation that, if defendants sought a deposition of iMesh, it would seek leave of Court to do so, in light of the previous deposition of iMesh in this litigation. I can confirm that we will agree to such a stipulation.

Please let me know your clients position with respect to the production of documents. Thank you.
